The new skating season begins July 1, 2010. **You must renew your membership by July 1, 2010** if you plan to test, compete or need a competition application certified by a club officer after June 30, 2009. You may renew your membership on of two ways: 1) complete and return the attached for OR 2) renew online at www.peninsulaskatingclub.org.

This year's membership types are as follows:

Skater + 2 Parent Package	Full membership for one skater and membership for both parent's of a skater under 18 years of age
Skater + Parent Package	Full membership for one skater and membership for one parent of a skater under 18 years of age
Full Membership	Home club membership. Required for testing and competing and ice buying
Second Family Member	Full membership for an additional skaters in the same family
Associate	For skaters whose home not is NOT PSC, but wish to skate on club ice or test on PSC sessions at member rates
Intro	For skaters new to figure skating. This membership is good for skaters first membership year
Alumni	For former PSC skaters and parents who no longer actively skate, but wish to continue their affiliation with PSC
Coaches	For skating professionals. Required for credentials at US Figure Skating qualifying competitions. Full membership benefits.
Officials	For judges, accountants, music and other US Figure Skating officials
Collegiate	One fee for 4 years and must be in college for the 4 year period and be between the ages of 18 and 25. This level includes full member benefits.
Special Olympics	Full membership benefits

50% discount applied to membership fees for applications received after March 31, 2011 for new members to Peninsula Skating Club only.

PENINSULA SKATING CLUB DESCRIPTION OF VOLUNTEER ROLES

Before to competition:

Awards- Purchase awards (medals/ribbons/trophies)

Credential-Prints and laminates credentials for skaters, coaches, officials and volunteers.

Facilities-Help with setup, tear down and storage of the competition equipment.

Program design/Printing-Help with the design, layout and printing of programs.

Sponsors/Advertising-Source sponsors and advertising for competitions and programs.

Volunteer coordinator- Work with committee chairs to fill all volunteer positions by emailing and contacting club members and other potential volunteers.

During the competition:

Accounting room- Tabulates results for events.

Announcing-Work with the music people to keep the competition going, announce skaters taking the ice.

Hospitality-Help by catering, donating or stocking and serving food for judges and coach/volunteer areas.

Ice Monitor-Monitor all skaters entering the ice for practice ice, warm up and competition.

Medical-Provide medical treatment to skaters during the competition.

Music Coordinator- Sets up the sound system and/or plays music during competition.

Practice Ice – Similar to registration, check in arriving skaters for practice ice, manage music drop off and pick up, answer general questions.

Registration-Check in arriving skaters for competition, manage music drop off and pick up and answer general questions.

Runner- Running music to and from registration/practice ice desk to music station. Also running judges sheets from judges stand to official accountant's room and posting final results.

Transportation - Picking up judges from the airport and transporting judges and officials between hotel and competition venue.

Requires US Figure Skating certification prior to volunteering

Judge- Evaluates the quality of performances

Technical Panel- Evaluates elements performed and the level of difficulty.
